His theatrical training began at the renowned *Piccolo Teatro School of Theatre* in Milan, under the direction of the legendary Giorgio Strehler. He graduated summa cum laude from the University of Milan and earned a master's degree in directing from the University of Southern California in Los Angeles, experience that enabled him to work as an assistant director at the New York Kaye Playhouse (Hunter College).

He has performed in international tours in major productions directed by masters such as Giorgio Strehler and Peter Stein. He has produced, directed and performed plays of both classical and contemporary authors, including Sophocles, Samuel Beckett, William Shakespeare, Dario Fo, Plato, Éric-Emmanuel Schmitt, Charles Dickens, Anton Čechov, and others.

He is currently an acting teacher and director at the Catholic University of Milan. He has led intensive courses in public speaking, team building and the use of theatre techniques to improve non-verbal and paraverbal communication for institutions including Gucci, the University of Trento and the University of Insubria.
